Topic

Science: Compare and group together different rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. Describe and explain the differences between sedimentary and igneous rocks, considering the way they are formed. Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. Understand that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

History: Changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age: Archaeology, early communication, food and life for early settlers.

Geography: Describe how volcanoes are created. Describe how earthquakes are created Describe how volcanoes have an impact on people's lives. Name a number of countries in the northern hemisphere. Locate and name some of the world's most famous volcanoes.



DT: Making a Neolithic ball, designing, shaping and moulding, and finishing techniques.
